One of the residents of the village, Mr. Obulesu, a farm labourer came across to get the leaflet and the literature related to SVP and immediately called the Helpline Number and explained that his wife Sujatha has been to Saudi, and she is suffering in the hands of her employer.

The AP State Coordinator of RED ALERT immediately contacted REDS and shared the information asking to take due action in this case. Responding at once, the REDS team met the Mr. Gorantla Madhav, Circle Inspector of Police, Kadiri, and filed an FIR in this regard. The CI was very prompt and determined to deal with the case. He immediately called the Brokers who sent her to Saudi, and warned them that she should be brought back to India within a week from that day. He, further, contacted the Saudi Police regarding the case, and also made the Brokers to talk to them and explain the matter.

As a part of the case, the CI also binded-over the Brokers to report to him at the police station every day, and to update the proceedings at both the ends. As the pressure built up heavily on the brokers, they booked flight tickets to her so that she can be flown back to India.

Finally, on June 3rd 2018 Ms. Sujatha returned to India, and reached her native place and reunited with her family. The joyous family is very much thankful to one and included in this entire episode of happy ending – RED ALERT, REDS, The CI of Police and the Government of India.
